Something that is wonderful is very good. Something that is terrifying is very scary. Therefore (C) is correct.

B

Broken is the opposite of repaired. Selfish is the opposite of generous. Therefore (B) is correct.

A

A characteristic of a knife is to be sharp. A characteristic of a crime is to be illegal. Therefore (A) is correct.

6) **C**

Boots are worn on the feet. Mittens are worn on the hands. Therefore (C) is correct.

A zebra is a type of animal. Green is a type of color. Therefore (A) is correct.

Obvious is the opposite of hidden. Liberal is the opposite of conservative. Therefore (C) is correct.
